



FRITZ LANG. He was regarded a genius, an egocentric sex maniac and a sadist. Violence and love became subjects that would not let go of Fritz Lang for the rest of his life.

In Vienna, as the son of a violent father, under whom his much-loved Jewish mother suffered. As a soldier in Galicia, where he experienced the horrors of the First World War. And finally as a young director in Berlin, accused of murdering his own wife.

In 1930, looking for suitable material for his first sound film, star director Fritz Lang travels from Berlin, leaving his turbulent environement behind, to Duesseldorf to witness the investigations headed by famous detective chief inspector Gennat into the brutal serial murderer Peter Kürten.

FRITZ LANG researches the "Evil" in all of us and in himself. We are drawn into the middle of the tense and frightening story behind the film classic *M*.
